WHAT ARE THE CHANGES?

The Protecting Access to Medicare Act (PAMA) requires that physicians ordering advanced imaging exams consult Appropriate Use Criteria (AUC) through a qualified Clinical Decision Support Mechanism (qCDSM).

January 1, 2020 marks the formal start of the program, where healthcare providers must consult qualified CDSM when ordering advanced imaging tests. Under the program, consultations must occur across all advanced imaging and evidence of consultation must be included on the claim.

The consultation requirement applies to all Medicare Part B Advanced Diagnostic Imaging Services (CT, MR, NM, PET) across multiple care settings including outpatient and emergency departments.

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WHAT IS THE TIMELINE?

January 1, 2020 marks the formal start of the program. From this date forward, healthcare providers must consult a qualified Clinical Decision Support Mechanism (qCDSM) when ordering advanced imaging tests furnished under Medicare Part B. Under the program, consultations must occur across all advanced imaging, and evidence of consultation must be included on all claims.

WHERE ARE WE TODAY?

The program starts with a one-year "Educational and Operations Testing Period". During this period, AUC consultation must occur across all advanced imaging, and evidence of consultation must be included on the claim. Incorrectly formed evidence will not result in payment being withheld.

HOW WILL THIS IMPACT WORKFLOW?

Providers can consult Clinical Decision Support (CDS) through a variety of resources. Your EMR vendor may integrate with a qCDSM. PRACTICAL TAKE-A-WAYS

- Ordering provider must document AUC consultation at the time the test is ordered.
- The CDS mechanism will time/date stamp the AUC Consultation when it generates the "Unique Decision Support Number" for a particular test.
- CMS mandate will not, at least initially, result in hard denials of reimbursement for "inappropriate"/ "rarely appropriate" studies.
- CMS will immediately begin collecting data on referring physician's patterns of adherence to AUC.
- Starting in 2020, CMS must use this data to identify up to 5% of physicians as being "outliers" in adherence to AUC.
