How We Work

Personal medical findings are referred to the employee's personal physician so that our program can focus on best servicing the needs of our employer groups. Communication is a priority and is key to how we work. Following treatment, employers are called and

a written statement is sent describing the employee's work status. A special software allows us to track each case, and when combined with our interdisciplinary approach to care, we are able to ensure all receive proper and timely follow-through.

Physicals

A variety of options are available, including health risk assessments, pre-employment physicals, return-to-work physicals, respirator clearance, hazardous material screenings and U.S. Department of Transportation/ Coast Guard physicals.

Drug & Alcohol Testing

Drug and alcohol collections are completed by certified collectors following all chain of custody guidelines. We also have the ability to fully manage a company's screening program based on their individual requirements.

Health & Safety

In addition to vaccines, immunizations, hearing conservation tests, and exposure monitoring, employee safety education is also available in the areas of back safety, accident management and pathogen compliance.

Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) is a discipline aimed at protecting the safety, health and welfare of people engaged in work or employment.

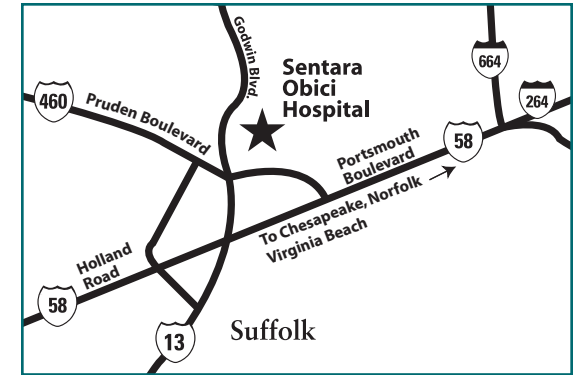
Additionally, the International Labour Organization (ILO) and the World Health Organization (WHO) have a shared definition that says Occupational health should aim at:

- Placing workers in an environment that matches their respective physiological and psychological capabilities;
- And, to summarize, the adaptation of work to man and of each man to his job.

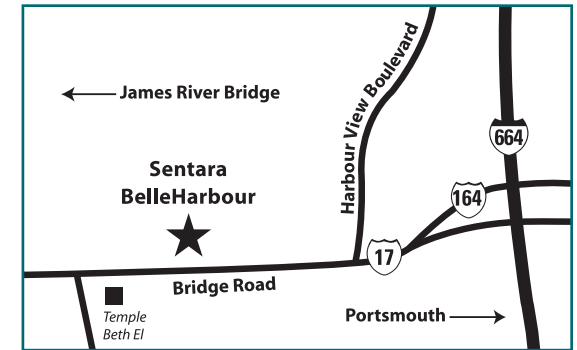
