During his first two years of college, Dr. Barber enrolled in the Army ROTC program, and during his last two years he served as a 2nd Lieutenant in an Army unit in Niagra Falls, NY. After college Dr. Barber transferred to the US Navy Medical Corps and attended the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences in Bethesda, MD, where in 1987 he graduated as a Doctor of Medicine with the rank of Lieutenant. Dr. Barber received his general surgery training at Naval Medical Center, Portsmouth.

After duty assignments which included the USS Mount Whitney, Naval Medical Center, Portsmouth, and Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, Dr. Barber completed his vascular surgery fellowship at The Cleveland Clinic in Cleveland, OH. From 2001 until he retired from the Navy in June 2003, Commander Barber, MC, USN, served as a vascular surgeon at Naval Medical Center, Portsmouth. Immediately prior to his retirement from the Navy, Dr. Barber served in Kuwait at a field hospital in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
